Paper 2 25% 70 marks	Speaking	F = 7-9 minutes (plus 12 minutes preparation) H = 10-12 minutes (plus 12 minutes preparation)	Students will be assessed through 3 tasks: 1. Role play 2. Q. based on picture stimuli and 3. Conversation Reward Spontaneity and Interaction

Speaking – Both Tiers

- 3 tasks Role play, picture based and conversation
- Conversation in two parts Candidate's presentation and Examiner questions
- Candidate submits selected topic for conversation 2 weeks in advance
- Candidate has 12 Min Preparation time
- Makes notes on tasks 1 and 2 on one page

Speaking – Foundation

- Total 7 to 9 Minutes + 12 Minutes Prep
- Note taking allowed in Prep I page
- Role Play Themes I-4 for I to I.5 Minutes
- Picture based tasks I-5 for 2.5 to 3 Mins.
- Conversation based on 2 themes
- One by Candidate, second by Board
- Conversation for 3.5 to 4.5 Mins

Speaking - Higher

- Total 10 to 12 Minutes + 12 Minutes Prep
- Note taking allowed in prep I page
- Role Play Themes 1-4 for 2 to 2.5 Minutes
- Picture based tasks I-5 for 3 to 3.5 Mins.
- Conversation based on 2 themes
- One by Candidate, second by Board
- Conversation for 5 to 6 Mins



Questioning

Must allow candidates to

- Answer quite freely
- Produce extended sequences of speech
- Develop conversations વાતચીત and discussions ચર્ચા
- Give and justify પુરવાર સાથે thoughts વિચારો and opinions મંતવ્યો
- Use a wide variety ดิดอนุส of tenses มด
- Respond to unpredictable **wewward** questions



Foundation & Higher

Candidates given paper in Preparation Time

- 5 utterances to 5 bullet points in 1 to 1.5 Minutes
- Assessment focus on Communication (वातथीत)
- Each answer carries a maximum of 2 marks, Total 10 marks
- Look at SAMs

Picture based tasks

- Candidates given paper with guidance in Gujarati during preparation time
- Examiner will ask 5 compulsory questions with no follow-up questions
- May repeat question but not change it
- For Higher level, one question unexpected
- Assessment on Communication + Content વાતચીત + વિગત (16 marks)
- And Linguistic Knowledge and Accuracy ભાષાજ્ઞાન + ચોકસાઇ (8 marks)
- Look at SAMs

Speaking - Conversation

- This is in 2 parts
- Part I Student will choose one Topic in advance of assessment
- Student presentation for 1 Min.
- Examiner will continue with the conversation
- Part 2 Examiner selects a different theme
- Assessment C&C, LK & A, Interaction and Spontaneity વાતચીત, વિગત, ભાષાજ્ઞાન, ચોકસાઇ, ચર્ચા અને તાત્કાલિકતા (36 marks)



- Encourage students to look at context સંદર્ભ of role play and respond appropriately
- Practise question forms, awareness of context સંદર્ભ પ્રમાણે in unexpected questions
- Develop note taking skills points not sentences
- Practise talking about pictures, develop discussion



- Not focus solely on picture, develop discussion about wider topic of picture
- Develop longer utterances, responding spontaneously લંબાવવું, વધારવું, તાત્કાલિકતા
- Develop answers by more details, justifying opinion, use different time frames વધુ વિગત, પુરવાર સાથે, અનેક કાળ
- Develop and incorporate higher level grammatical structures for the Higher paper

Higher Grammatical Structures

- Varied (વિધવિધ)and complex word order(જટિલ શબ્દ યોજના)
- Using extended sentences including conjunctions, pronouns, reported speech, abstract ideas(સંયોજકો, સર્વનામ, ભૌતિક વિચારો વિ. નો વપરાશ)
- Conceptually more challenging language (વધારે અઘરી ભાષા)
