This one-day training course for all Gujarati language teachers has the following aims

- 1) It will give participants an opportunity to familiarise themselves with some of the important changes in the new GCSE Gujarati courses that will be examined in 2019 for the first time
- 2) It will discuss and suggest how teachers can plan more effective lessons that will also cater for the needs of children at different ability or attainment levels in their classes.
- 3) It will give teachers of Nursery and Primary children some interesting strategies and ideas to engage and motivate their classes
- 4) It will give participants successful strategies for achieving better levels of classroom behaviour.
- 5) And finally it will look at challenges facing Head teachers and leaders of schools and how these might be addressed.

We will also show some examples of good practice in videos taken at mainstream schools in the UK.

We hope that you will find the course helpful in raising the quality of your pupils' learning and in improving their knowledge, understanding and skills in Gujarati.
