


## GCSE Gujarati – Overview

- The use of dictionaries is not permitted for any of the papers. This includes during preparation time for speaking.
- Short translations from and into the target language.
- Some target language questions in the reading and listening paper.
- Authentic stimuli in the reading, including literary texts.

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## GCSE Gujarati – Overview

- 25% assessment weightings per skill (listening, speaking, reading and writing).
- All 4 skills assessed separately

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- Students must complete their speaking assessment in April/May and all other assessments in May/June in any single year.
- Two tiers Foundation and Higher.
- Students must be entered for a single tier across all papers no mixed entry.




## GCSE Gujarati – Delivery Model An editable Course Planner and example Schemes

- A focused revision period at the end of the course


