- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses

You can use your own ideas **or** you could include these ideas:

- say where you live and what your local area is like (e.g. town/village/noisy)
- describe your journey to school (e.g. walk/by bus/by car)
- give details of what you did, or plan to do, on a walk with friends to explore your local area and say how you feel about it
- say whether or not you think that public transport is the best way to get around your local area and why
- say what changes would make it easier for young people to walk or cycle to local places and why

Remember:

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses

- say what sports you do (e.g. football/swimming/tennis)
- give details of your favourite food and drink (e.g. fish/curry/fruit juice)
- describe a day that you recently spent, or plan to spend, learning how to cook healthy food and say how you feel about it
- say whether or not you think that you and your family have a healthy lifestyle and why
- say what you would do to encourage young people to eat better and exercise more and why

Write **an email** to a friend in Gujarat about celebrations you have on special occasions.

Remember:

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses

You can use your own ideas **or** you could include these ideas:

- say which special occasions you celebrate (e.g. weddings /religious festivals /birthdays)
- give details of a cultural event in your school or area (e.g. dance /show /music)
- describe a special occasion you have celebrated at home, or plan to celebrate there, and say how you feel about it
- say whether you prefer to celebrate special occasions with your family or with friends and why
- if you could plan a surprise celebration for a friend or family member say where it would be, how you would make it very special and why

Write a **script** for a short documentary film about different cultures.

Remember:

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses

You can use your own ideas **or** you could include these ideas:

- say which languages you speak (e.g. English/French/Gujarati)
- give details of your favourite traditional music (e.g. classical/folk/Gujarati)
- describe a holiday that you recently had, or plan to have, to experience the language, traditional music, dances, clothes and food of a different culture and say how you feel about it
- say whether or not you think that travelling to other countries is a good way to understand different cultures and why
- say where you would take a guest from Gujarat who would like to experience your local culture, what you would see and do and why
