- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses.

- say what you do to help in your home (e.g. cooking/cleaning/washing up)
- give details of what you have done and/or plan to do to help your neighbours with their shopping or gardening and say how you feel about it
- say whether or not you think that it is interesting to grow flowers and vegetables and why
- if you could design your dream home, say where it would be, what it would look like, what would make it special and explain your choices.

Write a report for your local newspaper about a dance workshop for people of all ages.

### Remember:

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses.

You can use your own ideas or you could include these ideas:

- say what exercise you usually do to keep healthy
- describe a style of dance you are interested in (e.g. street dance/hip hop/folk dance)
- give details of what you did and learned in the dance workshop and say how you felt about it
- say whether or not you think that dancing can be good exercise for people of all ages and why
- if you could help to plan another dance workshop, say what you would do to make it even better and give your reasons why.


#### **Question 3** Leisure and entertainment

Write an essay about your favourite entertainer.

#### Remember:

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses.

You can use your own ideas or you could include these ideas:

- say who your favourite entertainer is and what s/he does (e.g. sings/plays music/tv star/film star)
- describe this entertainer and say what makes you a fan
- give details of what s/he did in a recent show/concert/film and/or plans to do in the future and say how you feel about it
- say whether or not you prefer to go to live concerts and shows than to watch films and recorded television programmes and explain why
- if you could watch your favourite entertainer perform in a special place, say where you would go, who would go with you and give reasons why.


## Question 4 Travel and the wider world

Write a blog about journeys and different ways to travel.

#### Remember:

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses.

You can use your own ideas or you could include these ideas:

- describe your normal journey to school
- say how you like to travel when you go on holiday (e.g. car/coach/taxi)
- give details of a boat or train journey that you have made and/or plan to make and say how you feel about it
- say whether or not you think that a journey can be more interesting than arriving at your destination and why
- say what would be your ideal journey anywhere in the world, who you would like to travel with and give reasons why.


#### Question 5 Education and work

Write an article for your school website about the advantages of having a part-time job.

#### Remember:

- to give factual information **and** explain ideas and points of view (your own or those of others)
- to use a variety of vocabulary, different types of sentences and different verb tenses.

You can use your own ideas or you could include these ideas:

- say what you usually do when you get home from school
- give details of a part-time job that you have or that one of your friends has (e.g. in a shop/restaurant/garden centre)
- describe what you have done and/or plan to do to find an interesting part-time job and say how you feel about it
- say whether or not you think that a part-time job is a good way to get work experience and why
- if you could learn a skill that would help in your chosen career, say what skill you would learn, what career you would like to have and explain your choices.
